

Morris Man. November 15th. 1935.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all the Council present, the minutes of former meeting held October 18th. were read and declared adopted as read.

Mr. Mousseau of Aubigny interviewed the Council in connection with the purchase of a car of green tamarac planking, after a discussion the following resolution was passed,

Moved by Councillor McDonald,
Seconded by Councillor Clubb,

That a car load of Green cut Tamarac plank be ordered by this Municipality for bridge work, planks to measure not less than 5 inches wide, and three inches thick in the following lengths, and prices,

9 foot lengths at a price of \$35.00 per thousand,
18 " " " " \$40.00 " and not more than 20 percent of the car to be in 9 foot lengths, prices F.O.B. Morris.

Carried.

Mr. Eric Bunkowsky interviewed the Council in connection with a damaged truck caused by a defective bridge, he asked that the Council recompense him to the amount of \$24.00 after a discussion the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,
Seconded by Councillor Gehring,

That Eric Bunkowsky be paid the sum of \$15.00 in full for damaged radiator etc, caused by a defective bridge.

Carried.

The Union of Manitoba Municipalities Convention was discussed and the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Councillor Thiesen
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That this Council attend the convention of Union of Manitoba Municipalities, and that Councillor Snarr be appointed as voting delegate (carried)

Mr. Julius Marsh interviewed the Council in connection with the payment of his past due rent, and asked that the Council pay the same he stated if his rent was paid he thought that he would be able to manage without relief for the winter.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,
Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That the back rent amounting to \$38.00 on Julius Marsh's house be paid to C.O. Loewen,

Carried.

A number of applications were received for relief, and the same were gone into and recommendations were made.

Bills and accounts were handed to the finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Gehring,
Seconded by Councillor Thiesen

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheque for the several amounts,

Carried)

Several Communications were read and ordered fyled.

The meeting then adjourned.
