

Morris, Manitoba,
January 15th, 1937.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all the members present. Council assembled at 1 P.M. and minutes of former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Several applications were received in connection with relief and considered. A discussion took place regarding the amount allowed per family for Groceries.

Moved by Councillor Gehring,

Seconded by Councillor Snarr,

That the relief allowance for Groceries for each family in this Municipality be raised one dollar per month this amount does not include flour, fuel and milk. (Carried).

A discussion took place in connection with the scraping, painting, and reflooring the Silver Plains ferry. Mr. Leon Bouchard stated he would do the work for the sum of \$60.00.

Moved by Councillor Stevenson,

Seconded by Councillor McDonald,

That Leon Bouchard be given the work of painting, scraping and reflooring the Silver Plains ferry at a price of \$60.00, said ferry to receive two coats of paint, and that Councillor McDonald be appointed to inspect the work. (Carried).

By-Law No. 584 was read a first time.

Moved by Councillor Gehring,

Seconded by Councillor Thiesen,

That by-law No. 584 being a by-law for the purpose of authorizing the assignment of Tax Sale Certificate No. 19, covering the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16-4-1W from the Rural Municipality to the W. S. Newton & Company, having been read the first time be now considered as having been read the second and third time and passed, and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the same. (Carried).

The Council again discussed the cutting of the wood on road allowance between Lots 351 and 353 it was decided to hire relief recipients to do the work at a price per cord.

Bills and accounts were handed to the finance Committee, the Finance Committee recommended that the Treasurer be authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Gehring,

Seconded by Councillor Thiesen,

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. (Carried).

The meeting then adjourned.
