

Morris, Manitoba.
September 19th, 1941.

A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all the members present.

The minutes of the last meeting held August 15th were read and adopted as read.

The question of building a bridge on the Loer Farm Highway was discussed, also the matter of gravelling said Highway.

Moved by Councillor Spalding,
Seconded by Councillor Davidson,

That this Council appoint Reeve Heppner and Councillor Stevenson, a Committee to interview the Provincial Government re Highway bridge, also for procuring gravel for the roads from the Eastern Boundary of said Highway to Kane. Carried.

Heine Bros. of Brunkild interviewed the Council in connection with an accident that happened to their hired men whilst crossing bridge with a harvesting machine, the Council stated that they would investigate the cause of the accident.

Combot Bros. interviewed the Council in connection with the repairing of a grade adjacent to their farm stating that they would do the work if a grader was furnished. Councillor McDonald agreed to locate a grader.

Mr. Robert asked that the grade near his farm east of Aubigny be repaired. The Council were not in a position to grant his request at the present time.

A letter was received from the Superintendent of the Canadian Pacific Railway in connection with the crossing at Sewell.

Mr. Peckover wrote to the Council in connection with an account submitted for O. Webster. The Clerk was instructed to send the said account to the Municipality of McDonald.

A letter was received from Vassar stating that the Riorden family who has been on a Municipal farm were moving out. The Council instructed the Clerk to write to Mrs. J. L. Hebert to kindly look after the place for the Council.

Bills and accounts were presented to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Clerk be authorized to pay the accounts as per list.

Moved by Councillor Snarr,
Seconded by Councillor Stevenson,

That the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to issue cheques for the several accounts. Carried.

The meeting then adjourned to meet on October 17th, as a Court of Revision.
