A regular meeting of the Council was held on the above date with all members present.

The minutes of the former meeting were read and declared adopted as read.

Prices on gravel were received from the Building Products & Coal Company, namely \$1.85 per cubic yard F.O.B. Sperling, Lowe Farm and Kane. It was decided to appoint a Committee to interview the Minister of Public Works in connection with the gravelling certain roads.

Seconded by Councillor Thiessen,

That Reeve Heppner and Councillors Stevenson and Anderson be a Committee to interview the Minister of Public Works in regard to assistance in gravelling the Lowe Farm-Kane Road and the Silver Plains-Aubigny Road. Carried.

Mr. Keating, representing the Richardson Machinery Company interviewed the Council in connection with a Road Maintainer. The Council decided not to invest at the present time.

Messrs. Penner and Esau interviewed the Council in connection with a raise in wages. The Clerk was instructed to write to the Department of Labor and obtain a schedule of rates applicable to Bridge Foremen and Laborers and Truck Drivers as set by the Board.

Mr. Alphonse Hebert interviewed the Council in connection with drainage on his property. Reeve Heppner and Councillor McDonald agreed to investigate.



Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee reported that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the accounts as per list.
