It was decided by Council that Mrs.Thiessen be allowed an extre bag of flour in January and that she be asked to produce an itemized statement as to how the January Family Allowance cheque is spent.

A letter from the highways branch of the Dept.of Public Works was read, in which they advised that grant of \$1,400.00 on a 50/50 basis was authorized for replacement of the intermunicipal bridge North of Section 36-4-2E. between Morris & Montcalm and to be financed by the R.M.of Morris.

A letter from the Powell Equipment Co., was read, in which they advised the cost of a new motor for the drag-line, and enother letter from the said Company was read in which they advised that the Elevating grader was not in alignment, causing the belt to run off to one side.

A letter from the Wpg.General Hospital was read, in which they advised that no indigent patients would be admitted to their hospital unless the Municipality would first agree to pay \$6.00 per day for their ward fee while in the hospital.

The meeting then adjourned, next meeting to be held in the Court House at Morris on Friday, Jan. 12th, commencing at the hour of 10.00 O'Clock in the forenoon.
