A letter from the Highways Branch of the Dept.of Public Works was read, in which they advised they had two firm bids re. repairing the intermunicipal bridge on the Morris - Dufrost road, one from the Harris Construction Co., for \$900.00 and \$ the other from Fraser Construction Co., for \$2,953.00. The Dept.edvised that they thought the bid of the Harris Construction Co.was quite fair and just.
