- Minutes. The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris met for regular session in the Court House Building in the Town of Morris on the above date. Reeve MacKenzie declaring the meeting open, the Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct, by motion of Councillors Bunkowsky and Saubette. CARRIED.
- Turbine to be ~~offered~~ offered for rent or sale. The Secretary informed the Council that Mr. Silversides of Hastings & Sons, Winnipeg, Manitoba had phoned and asked that they be given permission to rent one of our turbine sprayers. Neufeld-Stevenson; That we offer to rent a turbine sprayer to Hastings and Sons of Winnipeg for the Price of \$4.00 per day excepting Sundays, from the time they get it until they return it, or offer to sell it to them for the sum of \$1,000.00. If rented, the machine to be returned in good shape by written agreement. CARRIED. Recksiedler-Stevenson;
- Meeting re. Court of Revision to be Oct. 29th. That we hold a Special Meeting of Council on October 29th, 1952, commencing at 1.00 O'Clock in the afternoon, for the purpose of holding a Court of Revision re. Assessment Roll, to hear any complaints re. same and determine the Roll as revised to be the Assessment Roll for the year A.D. 1953. CARRIED.
- By-Law No. 780 re. Fire Hall Property. BY-LAW No. 780 was read a first time. Neufeld-Ribordy; That By-Law 780, being a BY-LAW for the purpose of authorizing the purchase of certain property for the erection of a Fire Hall thereon in the Village of Lowe Farm, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read the second and third times and passed, and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be hereby authorized to sign and seal same. CARRIED. Recksiedler-Stevenson;
- Hospitalization for Thiessens. Policy for the Thiessen Family, if possible. Ribordy-Neufeld; That we take out a Blue Cross Hospitalization Policy for the Thiessen Family, if possible. CARRIED.
- Festoon Light for Sperling. That the Manitoba Power Commission be requested to install one festoon light on Elevator and Main Streets in the Village of Sperling. CARRIED.
- Bills and Accts. Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer should be authorized to pay same as per list. Neufeld-Saurette; That the accounts amounting to the sum of \$33,776.72, approved by the Finance Committee be passed, and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. CARRIED.
- Delegations. Messrs. E. Lindquist and John Wiens from the North side of the Municipality attended at the meeting and asked that culverts be placed in the crossings by their farms. They were advised that if there appeared to be any error, an adjustment would no doubt be made.
- Correspondence. A letter from the Town of Morris was read, in which they asked permission to purchase an occasional plank which cannot be supplied from Local Lumber Yards. It was decided to sell them the occasional planks as the need arises. Letters from Dr. T.A. Pincock, Provincial Psychiatrist were read, in which he stated that Arnold Enns is not a mental defective, nor is he mentally ill. Also that it would be necessary to make an appointment to have Miss Elizabeth Wiebe examined by them in Winnipeg. A letter from the Canadian Federation of the Blind was read, in which they advised of some of their achievements and wished the Municipality to contribute to their cause. The Council felt that their problem was a federal responsibility. A letter from Judge Bernier was read in which he advised that the appeal of the Union Point School District against the petition of J.M. McDonald & Al, and the award of the Arbitrators was heard by him on the 22nd day of August 1952 and that the decision of him was on the 30th day of August 1952, determined by the confirmation of the award of the Arbitrators with cost as set out in his letter. The award of the Board of Arbitrators being that River Lots 482, 484, 486, 488, 490, 492, 494 and 496 all in the Parish of Ste. Agathe, in the Province of Manitoba be detached from the School District of Union Point No. 53. and added to the School District of Provencher No. 997.
- The meeting adjourned about 5.30 P.M., Next meeting to be held in the Court House Building on the 10th day of October 1952, commencing at 10.00 O'Clock in the forenoon.
