Minutes

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris met for the purpose of holding the regular monthly meeting in the Court House in the Town of Morris, on the above date, Reeve MacKenzie declaring the meeting opened, the Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct, by motion of Councillors Bunkowsky & Saurette.

CARRIED.

All members of the Council attended at the meeting.

Some discussion took place and information as to Arnold Enns' ability to work was made known to Council.

Aid re. Arnold Enns discontinued.

Bunkowsky-Neufeld;

That we discontinue the aid to Mrs. Enns re. the Maintenance of her son "Arnold";

Neufeld-Bunkowsky;

Aid re. P.M. Friesen- discontinued for time.

That due to the fact that Mr. P.M. Friesen is now receiving Old Age Pension, we discontinue the aid to him until such times as they request aid again.

Neufeld-Ribordy;

Pay 2/3 cost of Dist. Convention.

That we pay two thirds the cost of the District Municipal Convention held at Morris this year and we issue our cheque to the Town of Morris after amount of same is made known in detail.

Stevenson-Recksiedler;

CARRIED.

Geo Smith to wire shed.

That we accept the tender of George Smith to wire the Municipal shed as per plan, at the price of \$319.95. All materials included.

CARRIED.

Recksiedler-Saurette;

Committee to interview Dept. re grants.

That a committee of Reeve MacKenzie, and Councillors C.J. Neufeld and M.L. Ribordy interview the Dept. of Public Works re higher grants for gravelling market roads in the R.M. of Morris.

CARRIED.

Bills and accounts were handed to the Finance Committee, who reported that the Treasurer should be authorized to pay same as per list

Neufeld-Saurette;

Bills and Accts.

That the accounts amounting to the sum of \$46,528.24 be passed, and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts.

CARRIED.

Bunkowsky-Neufeld;

Roadway purchased from Frank Siemens.

That we advance Frank Siemens the sum of \$200.00 re. land bought from him for Right-of-Way.

CARRIED.

Correspondence.

A wire from Hastings & Sons was read, in which they advised they would not require our Turbine sprayer this fall.

A letter from the Manitoba Hospital Service Association was read, in which they advised that they could not insure the Thiessen family re Hospitalization.

A letter from Filmore, Watson & Riley was read, in which they advised that the situation re. Mrs. Richard looked very doubtful and they would require more information re the Berthalette twins.

Delegations

Mr. E.P. Chaput attended at the Meeting with regard to fire-fighting Equipment.

Mr. Abram F. Wisbe attended at the meeting re. cancellation of some of the Taxes against his property. He was advised that same would be attended to.

Mr. D. Heppner attended at the meeting with regard to the property taken for drainage and stated that a settlement should be made as per original agreement with Penners of Kane, Man.

The meeting adjourned, Nomination Meeting to be held on the afternoon of Tuesday, Oct. 14th and Court of Revision re. the assessment roll to be held on Wed. Oct. 29th as per minutes of Sept. 12th, 1952. Next regular meeting to be held on Friday, Nov. 14th commencing at 10.00 O'Clock in the forenoon.

Nominations were held on Oct. 14th as per the "Municipal Act." Nominations were open for Councillors for Wards one, two and four. The Secretary declaring Nominations closed at 2.00 O'Clock P.M., read the nominations and acclamations as follows: Ward one, Wm. Recksiedler, Ward two- Leslie Stevenson, and Ward four - Edmond Saurette, all acclaimed for the years 1963 and 1964.

By motion of Messrs. Bunkowsky and F. Moody, M.J. Stevenson was chairman for the meeting. Calling on each Councillor in turn, they all outlined their activities in their respective wards and were ready to answer any questions directed to them. Reeve MacKenzie was then called on to sum up the work of the Municipality as a whole and read and explain the Financial Statement for the month of September. All present appeared to be satisfied with the work progress of the Municipality and by motion of Messrs. F. Moody and C. Massinon, the report was accepted. After some discussion re. drains and seeding grass along same, by Messrs O Bunkowsky and F. Moody, the meeting adjourned.

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On the afternoon of Oct. 29th, the Council met in the Court House in the Town of Morris as per Minutes of Sept. 12th,. Reeve MacKenzie declaring the meeting opened as a Court of Revision re assessment Roll. Assessor Mr. Mazur was in attendance and all appeals were heard and dealt with. As two of the appeals could not be ~~determined~~ determined without further information, by motion of Councillors Hecksiedler and Stevenson, the Court adjourned until Nov. 14th, when it would be finalized .
