August 14, 1953

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris met in the Court House Building on the above date for the purpose of holding the regular monthly meeting. Reeve MacKenzie declared the meeting opened. The Secretary read the minutes of the last meeting, which were adopted as being correct by motion of Stevenson-Bunkowsky.

All members attended at the meeting.

Grant re Morris Agric. Society	Bunkowsky-Neufeld: That we make a grant of \$300.00 to the Morris Agricultural Society for 1953. Carried.
Arbitrator Sperling- Tremont S.D.	Recksiedler-Stevenson: That we appoint D. Heppner of Lowe Farm, as arbitrator re petition of L.L.Duvenaud et al, praying for the transfer of NW 10-6-2W from Tremont S.D. #1127 and adding same to the Consolidated School District of Sperling #1488. Carried
Road Gravel Lowe Farm to Kronswiede School	Neufeld-Bunkowsky: That we gravel the road from Lowe Farm to Kronswiede School, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles, with approximately 300 yds of gravel per mile. Cost of said gravelling to be on a Ward-ratepayer basis. Ward 5 to share up to \$1,000. out of its appropriation. Work to commence when ratepayers pay their share of monies as per agreement with Councillor of Ward 5. Carried.
Sewell to DeWet School- gravelling	Recksiedler-Stevenson: That we gravel the road from Sewell to DeWet School, $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, with 300 yds per mile, Cost of said gravelling to be on Ward-ratepayer basis. Ward 1 to share half the cost of gravelling. Work to commence when ratepayers pay their share of monies as per agreement with Councillor of Ward 1. Carried
Aid re J.F.Braun Lowe Farm	Neufeld-Bunkowsky: That we grant J.F.Braun aid of \$50.00 per month and cheque to be payable to Mrs. Mary F. Braun; payment to be retro-active to July 1st, 1953. Carried.
Accounts	That Neufeld-Saurette: That the accounts approved by the Finance Committee be passed, and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be hereby authorized to issue cheques for the several amounts. Carried.
Tax Arrears	The Tax Arrears situation was discussed and it was decided to notify all parties in arrears for more than 2 years, requesting payment, in order to avoid selling their property on Tax Sale. Carried
Petition Brunkild- Lowe Farm Road	A petition was presented to Council by Gordon Last et al, re regrading and gravelling the Brunkild-Lowe Farm road. Consideration for this program will be given in the 1954 season. The meeting adjourned and the next meeting to be held on Friday, * September 11th at 10 a.m. - Court of Revision Meeting will be held on Wednesday, Aug. 26, at 8.p.m to revise the Electors' Roll.
Office Floor	Stevenson-Neufeld: That we purchase linoleum from the Morris Lumber Yard, to be placed on the office floors at a price not to exceed \$140.00 Carried
Court of Revision re Electors Roll	COURT of REVISION re ELECTOR'S ROLL held Aug. 26, 1953 At the court of Revision on the above date, no complaints were lodged; Neufeld-Stevenson: That the revised list of Electors be posted up in all Post Offices in the Rural Municipality of Morris. Carried Saurette-Recksiedler: That the Court of Revision re the Electors Roll be now closed and the revised List of Electors as printed, be the lists for the year 1953, subject to the approval or changes made by the County Court Judge. Carried.
