increase remuneration of Council. rescinding By-Law 782 Recksiedler-Neufeld: That By-Law No. 794 rescinding By-Law No. 782 and increasing the remuneration of Reeve and Councillors, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed, and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign and seal same. Carried

O.A.P. I.Lindquist Bunkowsky-Saurette: That the Old Age Pension application of Mrs Ida Lindquist be recommended for approval to the Old Age Pension Board. Carried

Mun Aid R Berthelette Saurette-Neufeld: That we pay \$36.00 to Mrs. Roae E Berthelette of Abigny for her 1953 fuel supply. Carried

Rebate of taxes re Sewell Road Recksiedler-Stevenson: That the 1952 taxes be rebated and the 1953 taxes cancelled, on the property taken for road allowance through Sections 1 and 12 in Twp. 4, Range 1 West and through Sections 7, 17, and 18 in Twp. 4, Range 1 East, as described in By-Law No. 783. Carried

Assessment C. of R. Oct. 21. Neufeld-Saurette: That the Court of Revision re the Assessment Roll be held on Wednesday, October 21st at 1:30 o'clock in the afternoon, for the purpose of hearing any complaints against the assessment, and adopting the revised Roll for the year 1954. Carried.

Low Farm Fire Hall Ribordy-Stevenson: That resolution of March 23 re Low Farm Fire Hall be rescinded and the original resolution of April 10th, 1952 be left in force. Carried

Additional aid from D.P.W. re St. Mary's Road Neufeld-Saurette: In view of the fact that the St. Mary's Road in our Municipality is the main artery of transportation East of the Red River; and whereas, \$7,588.15 has been expended on gravelling this road in 1953; Now therefore, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris humbly petitions the Dept. of Public Works for an additional Grant in Aid of \$2,000.00 for the St. Mary's Road. Carried

Accounts Bunkowsky-Neufeld: That the accounts approved by the Finance Committee be passed, and the Reeve and Sec.-Treas. be hereby authorized to pay same. Carried.
