The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris met in the Court House Building on the above date for the purpose of holding its regular monthly meeting. After the Reeve declared the meeting opened, the Secretary read the minutes of the March 12th meeting, which were adopted as read by motion of O. Bunkowsky and L. Stevenson.

All Members of the Council were present.

Stevenson-Saurette:

Old Age Applications That the Old Age Pension applications of Dennis Kenny, Aubigny and Jacob T. Kroeker of Rosenhoff, be approved. Carried

Neufeld-Ribordy:

Blue Cross J.F. Braun That, providing Jacob F. Braun, Lowe Farm is covered by Blue Cross Hospitalization, we pay his yearly premium re same. Carried.

Approval of Council re Gratis Work

of Ribordy-Neufeld: That all gratis work done by Municipal Equipment must have the approval of the Council by resolution. Carried.

Accts.

Bunkowsky-Saurette:

That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$24,117.61 be passed and the Reeve & Sec. Treasurer be hereby authorized to pay same. Carried.

Delagations D. Heppner, Lowe Farm & L. A. Slater, Morris attended re Special Survey of land not subdivided in Village of Lowe Farm. Further enquiry and information to be obtained from District Registrar.

H. Gilbert of T.J. Pounder & Co., Dennis Payette of Roscoe Culverts and I. Chemish of Manitoba Barrel & Drum Co., attended, soliciting orders for culverts.

Correspondence Archie Delorm, Aubigny, requests payment of piling delivered. As order was not fulfilled as promised, this account was not approved until contract fulfilled.

Council instructed the Secretary to file liens against property owners, whose hospital or municipal aid accounts were paid by the Municipality, unless other suitable arrangements had been made before such filing.

J. G. Harvey account re Altona Hospital District was presented but not approved for reasons that Council felt this payment should be made by the Altona Hospital Board.
