The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date, with all members present.

Upon motion of O. Bunkowsky and E. Saurette, the minutes of the April 9th session were adopted as read.

Legion Wreath	Neufeld-Recksiedler: That we purchase a Wreath for the Decoration Day Services to be held on Sunday, June 20th, on behalf of the Morris Branch of the Canadian Legion. Carried
Bicycle Traffic; Lowe Farm	Neufeld-Stevenson: That Donald Harder, Lowe Farm, be appointed inspector to control Bicycle & Motorcycle traffic on sidewalks in the Village of Lowe Farm. Carried
Old Age Pension	Saurette-Bunkowsky: That the Old Age Pension application of Mrs. Mary Hebert of Aubigny, be approved. Carried
Parking area for Lowe Farm	Neufeld-Bunkowsky: Whereas parking facilities on Main Street in the Village of Lowe Farm are taxed to the limit, due to one-way parking only on the North side of the street, Now therefore be it resolved that we petition the Department of Public Works, Highways Branch, Winnipeg, for a substantial grant, to widen P.T.H. No. 23 on the South side of the street, in the Village of Lowe Farm, to provide additional parking area, as per specifications prepared by the Highways Branch. Carried.
Insulin R Berthelette	Saurette-Neufeld: That we agree to pay one-half the wholesale cost of Insulin required by Mrs. Rose Berthelette of Aubigny. Carried.
Cemetery purchase NE31-4-1W	Neufeld-Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 804, being a By-Law for the purpose of purchasing land for a Cemetery on Part NE 31-4-1WPM having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed, and the Reeve and Sec.-Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign and seal same. Carried
Accounts	Neufeld-Saurette: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$31,734.93 be passed and the Reeve & Sec.-Treasurer be hereby authorized to pay same. Carried
Petition Rosenhoff from Flowery Bank	A petition was presented to Council requesting the transfer of NW 9-5-1 EPM from Flowery Bank S.D. to Rosenhoff S.D.
I.F.C.C. Tree Planting project	The Lowe Farm Chamber of Commerce presented a brief for consideration of Council, for a proposed tree-planting-soil conservation project. Considerable discussion followed as to the best method to be used to prevent soil drifting.
Voters' List	It was agreed that each Councillor be an enumerator in his Ward to make up a list of electors for the year 1954.

The meeting adjourned and the next regular meeting will be held on Friday, June 11th, 1954 at 10 a.m.
