NOMINATION DAY

A meeting of the electors of The Rural Municipality of Morris was held at 2 p.m. on the above date for the purpose of receiving nominations for Reeve and for Councillors of Wards 3, 5 and 6.

Leslie Stevenson was appointed chairman of the meeting.

The Returning Officer read the nominations received and as only the required number of candidates were nominated, declared

Reeve Cornelius J. Neufeld

and

Councillors:

Otto Bunkowsky, Ward Three

Henry B. Giesbrecht, Ward Five

Maurice Ribordy, Ward Six

selected by acclamation.

The chairman called upon each councillor to give a brief report on the work done in his Ward and the monies expended so far.

Reeve C. J. Neufeld presented the Financial Statement, copies of which were handed to the 17 electors present.

A question and discussion period followed. The main topics under discussion were:

1. An equipment foreman for the Municipality; due to the size of the and amount of equipment to be placed and checked, (municipality it was felt that the benefits received by hiring a foreman would not warrant the expense involved.
2. More Snow-plowing if our coming winter should be similar to that of last year. This would most likely call for additional taxes to be levied to cover the cost.
3. More road gravelling and re-grading.
4. Higher remuneration for Councillors was suggested in order that they could spend more time on supervision of work expected from them and also to encourage more ratepayers to accept the office of Councillor or Reeve.

The meeting adjourned at 4 p.m.
