Because the Morris Agricultural Representative area is very large, peculiarly designed and heavily populated:

And because the northern half of the area is not suitably served by all-weather connecting roads with the district office at Morris;
We the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris, appreciating the value of this service to our ratepayers, do hereby endorse and concur in the efforts of the Morris Agricultural Council to acquire an Assistant Agricultural Representative for the Morris Agricultural Representative Area.
