Inaugural Meeting The inaugural meeting of The Rural Municipality of Morris was held in the Court House building at Morris, on the above date. The oath of office was taken by the re-elected Reeve C.J. Neufeld and Councillors O. Bunkowsky, H.B. Giesbrecht and Maurice Ribordy, after which the meeting was declared opened. The minutes of the inaugural meeting held Jan. 4, 1955 were read and upon motion of W.F. Recksiedler and O. Bunkowsky adopted as read.

Office Salaries Bunkowsky-Saurette: That D.J. Harder's salary as Secretary-Treasurer for the year 1956 be set at \$3,300. a year and that of the Assistant Secretary-Treasurer be set at \$160.00 a month. Carried

By-Law 821 Time and Place of Meetings W.F. Schellenberg-H.B. Giesbrecht: That By-Law No. 821 fixing the time and place of meetings for Council Sessions and setting out the remuneration to be paid the Reeve and Councillors for the year 1956, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a ~~first~~ second & third time and passed and the Reeve & Sec.-Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign and seal same. Carried.
