

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

February 10 - 1956

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the January 13th meeting were read and adopted.

W.Recksiedler-H.B.Giesbrecht: Whereas a large number of farmers reside along and near the so-called Lowe Farm-Rosenfeld road, East of Sec's. 5, 8, 17, 20, 29 & 32 in Township 4, Range 1 W.P.M.

AND whereas this road has been and will be extensively used to divert traffic from PTH #14 while that road is under construction,

AND whereas this road is an extension of PTH 14A connecting PTH #14 and #23 and thus carries a large amount of traffic,

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that this Council requests the Minister of Public Works to take over this road and designate same as a Provincial Trunk Highway.

M.Ribordy-O.Bunkowsky: That we advertise for employees to fill the following positions for 1956 at the wages stated:

H&B.Giesbrecht-W.Schellenberg: That By-Law #822 approving a 5 year contract with the Manitoba Power Commission for the purpose of supplying electrical power for street lighting in the Village of Lowe Farm, having been read a first time, be considered as having been read a second & third time and passed.

O.Bunkowsky-W.Recksiedler: That By-Law #823 approving a 5 year contract with the Manitoba Power Commission for the purpose of supplying electrical power for street lighting in the Village of Kane, having been read a first time, be considered as having been read a second & third time and passed.

O.-Bunkowsky-W.Schellenberg: That we appoint M.J.Stevenson, Silver Plains, as arbitrator re petition of H.Hein et al requesting that the School District of Lone Star #1629 be dissolved and become part of the Consolidated School Districts of Sperling #1488 and Brunkild #1281.

Recksiedler-Saurette: That we appoint Trier Anderson of Sperling as arbitrator re petitions of D. J. Wiebe et al & Edward Janzen et al requesting the transfer of the SE 35-5-3W from MacNab S.D. and the NE 35-5-3 W from Brigdenley S.D. and adding same to the Tremont S.D.

Ribordy - Giesbrecht: That the accounts approved by the Finance Committee for \$5,508.75 be passed and the Reeve & Sec.-Treas. are authorized to pay same.
