BUDGET MEETING

March 23, 1956.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris met on the above date for the purpose of making estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the corporation for the year 1956.

The feeling of Council was not to increase taxes; however, due to the necessity and heavy demands for more Drainage Work and very heavy Snowplowing costs it was considered unavoidable to make some increase.

Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. Recksiedler: That the General Mill Rates for 1956 be set as follows:

Uncontrollable: 51.7 mills for General School Levy
4.2 mills for Drainage Maintenance

Controllable: 17. mills for Wards, Bridges, Health, Hospitalization, Municipal Aid, Road gravelling and construction, Machinery purchases, Administration costs, Noxious Weeds, etc.

TOTAL 26.9 Mills

AND all Special Levies to be as set out in By-Law #824, which having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed, and the Reeve and Secretary-treasurer are hereby authorized to sign and seal same.

The Budget Meeting adjourned.
