

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

April 13, 1956.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the March 13th session and those of the Budget meeting held March 23rd, were read and adopted by motion of Wm. Recksiedler and Wm. Schellenberg.

Aid Re R.Davidson, Sperling. Otto Bunkowsky-Wm.Recksiedler: That the aid of \$25.00 a month for Robert Davidson, Sperling, as approved on March 13th, be made payable to Canadian National Institute for the Blind.

Carried.

Purchase of No.12 Cat. Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. Recksiedler: That we purchase one No.12 Caterpillar Motor Grader Serial No. 8T-17089 with snow plow and wing from Powell Equipment Co. Ltd. for the price of \$25,960.00 with a trade-in allowance of \$1,960.00 for our elevator grader. Rental payment of \$7,000.00 made in December 1955 to be considered as payment on account.

By-Law #825 read a first time. Wm. Recksiedler-H. B. Giesbrecht: That By-Law #825 being a By-Law for the purpose of ratifying the supplementary scheme for living quarters for the staff at the Altona Hospital No. 24, and authorizing the necessary taxation under the scheme, be now read a first time and forwarded to the Municipal & Public Utility Board for approval.

Requesting Government to take over future maintenance of the La Salle Road. Wm. Schellenberg-Otto Bunkowsky: WHEREAS the "La Salle Road" extending through the Municipalities of Morris and Macdonald, from No. 75 P.T.H. at Morris, in a north-easterly direction to No. 3 P.T.H. at East 4-10-2 East, is a municipal responsibility for maintenance and upkeep. AND WHEREAS the Municipalities concerned have expended large sums of money over the past years in re-construction and gravelling, and have now a road of good standard. AND WHEREAS this municipal highway is used extensively by traffic other than local, and is a connecting highway between No. 75 P.T.H. at Morris and No. 3 P.T.H. at E 4-10-2 East, leading to Winnipeg.

NOW THEREFORE: The Councils of the Municipalities of Morris and Macdonald hereby request the Government to take over future reconstruction and maintenance.

Carried.

Accounts. Wm. Recksiedler-M. Ribordy: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$32,750.73 be passed and the Reeve and Sec.-Treas. are hereby authorized to pay same.
