NOMINATION DAY - OCTOBER 9, 1956

A meeting of the electors of The Rural Municipality was held at 2 p.m. on the above date for the purpose of receiving nominations for Councillors of Wards One, Two and Four.

The Returning Officer read the nominations received. As only the required number of candidates were nominated in Wards One and Two, he declared Councillors W. F. Recksiedler and W. F. Schellenberg elected by acclamation.

Ward Four had two nominations for Councillor, namely:

Edmond Saurette, Aubigny and Theo. Chezick, Aubigny, and it was announced that election day would be held on Friday the 19th day of October.

One ratepayer from Ward Four and three from Ward Five attended the meeting. Suitable harvest weather was felt to be the reason for poor attendance.

Copies of the Financial Statement were made available to those attending and certain expenditures were explained.

Unless demands for public services could be cut down, it was felt that taxes were bound to be increased somewhat, especially in the field of drainage work.

The meeting was adjourned about 3 o'clock.
