COURT OF REVISION

Wm. F. Schellenberg-Otto Bunkowsky: Resolved that the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris now assemble as a Court of Revision to hear complaints on the 1957 assessment.

Court of H. Giesbrecht-W. Recksiedler: That the Court of Revision having heard all written complaints and made its decisions be now adjourned and report its findings to the Council.

Giesbrecht: That By-Law #833 approving a 5 year contract with the Manitoba Power Commission for the purpose of supplying electrical power for Street Lighting in the Village of Sperling, having been read a first time, be considered as having been read a second & third time and passed.

Accounts. Wm. F. Schellenberg-Otto Bunkowsky: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$36,171.78 be passed and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized to pay same.

O. Bunkowsky-W. Schellenberg: That we request the Manitoba Power Commission to install one 100 watt street light in the Village of Rosenort on Kroeker St.
