

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

November 9, 1956.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present except Ward 5 Councillor. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the October 12th session were read and adopted by motion of Wm. Recksiedler and Ed. Saurette.

- Normandin Hall tax exempt for 5 years. Wm. Schellenberg-Ed. Saurette: That By-Law No. 834 exempting the "Normandin Hall" at Aubigny, Manitoba from taxes for a period of 5 years, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed.
Carried.
- Agreement with R. M. of Macdonald Re brush clearing. M. Ribordy-Otto Bunkowsky: That we agree to pay the Rural Municipality of Macdonald one third the cost of clearing brush out of the Morris River at Sections 34, 27 - 6 - 1W up to a maximum of \$1500.00, with the understanding that we share proportionately if Government assistance is received on this project - Rural Municipality of Macdonald to take care of clearing this brush.

- Date-Sale of bridge lumber Wm. Recksiedler-Otto Bunkowsky: That the annual sale of old bridge lumber be held on November 17th at 2 o'clock in the afternoon.
Carried.
- Tax due date extended. Wm. Schellenberg-Ed. Saurette: That, due to inclement weather conditions and a scarcity of grain quotas, we grant an extension of the customary due date for paying taxes without penalty, from October 31st to December 31st, 1956.
Carried.
- Oil Unit purchased for Residence. Wm. Recksiedler-Otto Bunkowsky: That we purchase one used oil unit and tank from G. Friesen, Morris for installation in the Municipal Residence at the price of \$175.00. This price to include complete installation.
Carried.
- Piling Ordered. Wm. Schellenberg-Otto Bunkowsky: That we order 300 lengths of piling from Archie Delorme of Aubigny with the following specifications:
150 - 20' lengths with not less than 8" tops.
150 - 15' lengths with not less than 8" tops.
at a price of 35¢ a foot, delivered at Morris.

- Pay Re hauling fuel for Dragl.#2. Wm. Schellenberg-Wm. Recksiedler: That we pay Edward Funk \$10.00 a month, retroactive to May 1st, for hauling fuel for Dragline #2.
Carried.
- Tenders to be received Lone Star S.D. It was decided to again offer the Lone Star School for sale but no tenders for less than \$2000.00 to be accepted.
- Accounts. Wm. Schellenberg-Wm. Recksiedler: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$157, 316.32 be passed and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized to pay same.
Carried.
