The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The meeting was opened by the Reeve after which the minutes of the November 9th session were read and adopted by motion of Wm. Recksiedler and Wm. Schellenberg.

By-Law No. 835 passed.

Wm. Recksiedler-Wm. Schellenberg: That By-Law No. 835 being a by-law for appointing polling places and setting the time for polls to remain open in Ward Five By-election having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second & third time and passed. Minutes Dec 12 Carried.

Enlarging Market Road System

Wm. Recksiedler-Otto Bunkowsky: That we approve the request made by the Municipality of Montcalm to the Department of Public Works, asking for the addition of the road North of Sec.'s 35, 34, 32 and 31-3-1E into the Market Road System; and that we request the Department of Public Works to include the road East of Sec. 1-4-1W into our Market Road System.

Request for Snow-Plowing Grant.

Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That we request the Department of Public Works for a snow plowing grant for the 1956-1957 season on the following main Market Roads: 1. Sperling-Aubigny Road 2. St. Mary's Road 3. Detour Road 4. Meridian Road 5. Lowe Farm - Brunkild Road 6. Kane - Sperling Road 7. Sewell Road 8. Lowe Farm - Rosenfeld Road 9. Detour - Rosenort Road
