Redemption from 1953 Tax Sale.

Ed. Saurette-Otto Bunkowsky: Whereas the Rural Municipality of Morris purported to sell at the 1953 Tax Sale parts of River Lot 446 of the Parish of Ste. Agathe; And Whereas it appears that the Municipality improperly sold a portion of the land included in the said Tax Sale Certificate; Now therefore, be it resolved that the Treasurer redeem from the Tax Sale pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 1131 of the Municipal Act, the following land:
Parcel 1: All that portion of River Lot 446 of the Parish of Ste. Atathe in Manitoba shown colored green on a plan filed in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 4400 which lies to the North of a straight line drawn South of, parallel to and perpendicularly distant 116 feet from the Northern limit of said Lot 446.
Parcel 2: All that portion of the most Northerly 116 feet in perpendicular width of said River Lot 446 which lies to the east of the Eastern limit of the land above described and to the West of a line drawn parallel to the Western limit of the land shown colored green on said Plan 4400 through a point in the Northern limit of said River Lot 446 distant Easterly thereon 6 chains from the said Western limit.
