

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

MORRIS MANITOBA.

APRIL 13, 1962.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of the March 9th Council meeting were read and adopted by motion of B. W. Thiessen and Maurice Ribordy.

- By-Law #89D passed. Otto Bunkowsky-Wm. F. Schellenberg: That By-Law No. 89D, being a By-Law for the purpose of correcting certain details in Certificate of Title No. 779709 held by the Rural Municipality of Morris, having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed. Carried.
- By-Law #890 passed. Otto Bunkowsky-Ed. Saurette: That By-Law No. ~~888~~<sup>889</sup> being a By-Law for the purpose of making estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year 1962 and setting out the various rates, as shown in "Schedule A", having been read a first time, be now considered as having been read a second and third time and passed. Carried.
- Request for a Special Snow-Flowing Grant. Wm. F. Schellenberg-Ed. Saurette: WHEREAS heavy snow-fall this season necessitated more use of snow plowing equipment than normally; AND WHEREAS our Municipality has over 100 miles of approved Market Roads and another 25 miles of School Division Bus Routes, as well as many miles of School Van Routes, to clear; AND WHEREAS the Municipality has done a good job of clearing said Bus Routes as confirmed by the Morris-Macdonald School Division; AND WHEREAS the cost of snow-plowing to March 31st, 1962 has amounted to almost \$10,000.00 (as per statement attached); NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris requests that a SPECIAL GRANT of \$2,000 be made by The Dept. of Public Works, over and above the "Municipal Snow-plowing Grant" available to every municipality, irrespective of size. Carried.
- Request for Special Grant for Access Road-Sperling. Maurice Ribordy-Ed. Saurette: That we request the Dept. of Public Works for a Special Grant of 100% of the proposed expenditures on the following projects: Access Road from P.T.H #3 through Village of Sperling along "Station Street" to "Section Road" and South to P.T.H. #3. Carried.
- Morris & Rhineland inter-municipal Road. B. W. Thiessen-Wm. F. Recksiedler: That we agree to rebuild and gravel the inter-municipal road between the Municipalities of Morris and Rhineland, being one mile South of Sec.6-4-2W providing Rhineland will share the costs of this project on a 50/50 basis. Carried.
- Accounts. Ed. Saurette-Maurice Ribordy: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$75,325.32 be passed for payment. Carried.

The meeting adjourned and the next regular meeting will be held on FRIDAY, MAY 11th, 1962 at 10 A.M.
