The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with Otto Bunkowsky, Deputy Reeve in the chair. Reeve Bruce MacKenzie was absent due to a special Drainage meeting called for this date in Winnipeg. All members of Council were present. The minutes of April 10th meeting were read and adopted by motion of C. J. Neufeld and M. Ribordy.

W.F.Schellenberg-Ed.Saurette: That we enter into an agreement with Ulric St. Godard, for a five-year period, to lease the existing Gravel Pit on Section 33-4-2 E.P.M.

W. F. Recksiedler-C.J.Neufeld: That we make a grant of \$25.00 to The Mental Health Association.

C.J.Neufeld-W.F.Recksiedler: That we make a grant of \$750.00 to the "Morris Manor" (Elderly Citizens Housing Unit).

W.F.Schellenberg-Ed.Saurette: That we request the Dept. of Public Works to commence construction of the "Aubigny Bridge" under the grant-in-aid program, in the 1964 season.

C. J. Neufeld-Ed. Saurette: That we purchase one Ford 4000 heavy duty Industrial Tractor from J. R. Friesen & Son, Morris, Man. for \$5,565.00 delivered at Morris, with attachments and specifications as per attached schedule.

Ed. Saurette-W.F.Schellenberg: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Board to include that portion of River Lots No's. 338 to 528, lying West of St. Mary's Road, into D.M.D. "X".

J. J. Janzen & Bob Forrest, representatives of the "Morris Manor" explained how the drive for funds for this project was progressing and solicited the support of Council.

J. Brako, P.Eng., reported as to the progress made thus far regarding the "Aubigny Bridge". The Provincial ~~share~~ share for construction of this bridge had been included in the 1964 estimates. Estimated share of the municipality was from \$94,000. to \$104,000. When contract is let on this project, same will call for completion by June 1965.
