Minutes The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of May 8th meeting were read and adopted by motion of C. J. Neufeld and Ed. Saurette.

Course in Municipal Administration W.F.Recksiedler-M.Ribordy: That we authorize closing of the office from June 15th to the 19th inclusive, while the office staff is attending the Course in Municipal Administration, and that the expenses connected therewith be paid by the municipality. Carried.

Substitute Ferry operator Ed. Saurette-W.F.Recksiedler: That we appoint Ulysses St.Jacques of Aubigny as a substitute Ferry operator for the Aubigny Ferry. Carried

Gravel Checkers C.J.Neufeld-W.F.Schellenberg: That we hire Isaac Klassen, Lowe Farm as gravel checker, to check gravel on roads, at \$1.30 an hour and 10 cents a mile travelling expenses; and Dave Brown as checker in the Pit at \$1.30 an hour and \$2.00 a day travelling expense. Carried

Aid C.Nicholson E. Saurette-M. Ribordy: That we pay \$30.00 a month, aid, to Mrs. Constance Nicholson of Morris, commencing June 1, 1964. Carried.

Grant Agric. Museum Otto Bunkowsky-W.F.Schellenberg: That we make a grant of \$25.00 to the Agricultural Memorial Museum at Austin, for 1964. Carried

Change Sperling Street Lighting M. Ribordy-C.J.Neufeld: That we authorize Manitoba Hydro to make the following changes to street lighting system in Sperling; It is agreed that this resolution will constitute an amendment to the street lighting contract now in force. :
(Deleting: one 100 Watt, five 150 Watt and six 300 Watt lights and Festoons (6 nights monthly),
and
Installing thirteen 175 Watt Mercury Vapor lights. Carried

Accounts W. Recksiedler-W.F.Schellenberg: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$23,529.71 be passed for payment. Carried

Representatives from Kane Equipt. attended the meeting.

A.P.Toews presented a request for the construction of a dam in the Tobacco Creek for water conservation. The Tobacco Creek is to be reconstructed and in view of this undertaking, his request was not granted.

The Secretary was instructed to notify municipal employees not to work on Thursday, July 16th, opening day of the Big M Stampede but to attend same. Employees authorized to list 10 hours work for this day.

A request from the Cons. S.D. of St. Agathe was received to gravel certain municipal roads because of school buses finding difficulty travelling same when wet. No action will be taken until these roads are designated as School Division Bus Routes.

Aid to B. E. Heinrichs was to be reduced to \$20.00 a month starting ~~July~~ 1st, as he is now receiving supplementary assistance and Medicare from the Dept. of Welfare.

The meeting adjourned, and the next regular meeting of Council will be held on Friday, July 10th, 1964, at 10 a.m.
