M. Ribordy-W.Recksiedler: That we appoint C.J.Neufeld as Chairman of the Dec. 11th council meeting fro reason that the Reeve is away to Calgary and the Deputy Reeve is hospitalized. Carried

W.F.Schellenberg-W.F.Recksiedler:
That the minutes of Nov. 13 meeting be adopted as read. Carried

M. Ribordy-W.F.Schellenberg:
That By-Law No. 926, being a by-law for the purpose of purchasing a D7 Cat. tractor for the sum of \$33,645.00, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed. Carried

W.F.Schellenberg-Ed.Saurette:
That By-Law No. 925, being a By-Law for the purpose of cancelling certain taxes and accounts receivable, be now read a second and third time and passed. Carried

W.F.R Recksiedler-M.Ribordy:
That we approve of hunting of foxes innour municipality, by aircraft, provided that applicants adhere to government regulations. Carried

W.F.Schellenberg-W.F.Recksiedler:
That we appoint C.J.Neufeld as out member to the Board of the Valley Agricultural Society for 1965. Carried

W.F.Schellenberg-Ed. Saurette:
That we pay our employees a bonus of 3% on their 1964 earnings, in lieu of holiday pay. - The Bridge crew to receive an equal bonus, according to time worked for the municipality and the Drainage Maintenance Boards. Carried.

That we pay the following honorariums for services rendered as Drainage Trustees in 1964:

W. F. Recksiedler-W.F.Schellenberg:
That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$213,248.79 be passed for payment. Carried
