The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. Candidates for Ward 3 By-Election, Ed. Bursthaler and G.P. Goossen attended the meeting. The minutes of March 12th meeting were read and adopted by motion of C. Neufeld and Ed. Saurette.

W.F. Schellenberg-C. Neufeld: That we approve the application of the Assesor to have changes in ownership and assessment made in the 1965 Tax Roll, as per "Exhibit A" of the Assessment Branch, dated April 1, 1965.

W.F. Schellenberg-W.F. Recksiedler: That we pay Abe H. Klassen, RRL-3, Morris \$80.00 a month aid, commencing April 1, 1965.

Ed. Saurette-W.F. Recksiedler: That we pay Jacob Penner, Lowe Farm, an honorarium of \$251.80 for services rendered as bridge foreman, during the past many years.

C.J. Neufeld-E. Saurette: That we approve of the erection of a Neon sign on top of the hopper of Western Gypsum Products Ltd. at Silver Plains, as referred to in Plan : Job No. TO-2569.

W.F. Recksiedler-C.J. Neufeld: That we hire Abe H. Harder of Lowe Farm as D7 Caterpillar (old) operator for 1965 at \$1.65 per hour.

E. Saurette-M. Ribordy: That we request the Manitoba Hydro to install three, 150 Watt incandescent street lights in the Village of AUBIGNY at the following locations: Lot 8, Lot 17 & Lot 7, Plan 3649.

W.F. Recksiedler-W.F. Schellenberg: That we contract with Johnny Dueck, Rosenort to haul, crush and spread gravel from our municipal pit, at the following rates: Crush & Load @ 55¢ a yard; Haul @ 8¢ per yard per mile.

W.F. Recksiedler-C.J. Neufeld: That we appoint Dan Recksiedler of Morris as arbitrator re the petition of John Doell and others praying for the dissolution and merging of the School Districts of Amsterdam #885, Reichenbach #1198, Rosenfeld #755 and New Kennedy #1573, and form the Consolidated School District of Rosenfeld #885.

C.J. Neufeld-W.F. Recksiedler: That we appoint Dick B. Eidse of RRL, Morris as arbitrator re the petition of Pete I. Brown and others requesting that the Rosefarm S.D. #1577 be dissolved and its lands transferred to the Consolidated School District of Kane No. 2006.

C. J. Neufeld-M. Ribordy: That By-Law No. 931, being a by-law for the purpose of making estimates of the sums required for the lawful purpose of the corporation for the year 1965 and setting out the various rates as shown in Schedule "A", having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed.


W.F. Schellenberg-Ed. Saurette: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$40,565.75 be passed for payment.
