
MAY 14, 1965.

Refund  
requested.
- C. J. Neufeld-M. Ribordy: Whereas municipal corporations are permitted by the Province of Manitoba a refund of 15¢ per gallon of the tax levied on diesel fuel used in construction of public highways,  
And Whereas many municipal corporations in many cases use gasoline in their equipment used for the construction of public highways due to the financial inexpediency to purchase equipment which uses diesel fuel, or for other valid reasons,  
Now Therefore be it resolved that the Province of Manitoba do refund to such municipality the tax levied on gasoline where consumed in equipment used for construction of public highways.
