

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

June 11, 1965

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of May 14th meeting were read and adopted by motion of C. J. Neufeld and Ed. Saurette.

W. Schellenberg - C. J. Neufeld: Whereas the establishment of Provincial Waterways went into effect May 1st, 1965,

And Whereas under this policy there would be no justification for the continuation of the Drainage Maintenance Districts in our municipality;

Now Therefore, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris requests the Minister of Agriculture and Conservation, to dissolve Drainage Maintenance Districts "X", "E", "V3", "V4" and "G" situate in our municipality.

Carried.

C.J.Neufeld-W.F.Recksiedler: Whereas the "Shannon Floodway" in our municipality has caused considerable damage to property, through flooding, in 1962 and again in 1965, in spite of its reconstruction in 1960;

Now Therefore the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris requests the Minister of Agriculture, Water Control & Conservation Branch, to re-design this floodway in such a manner that it would carry more flow adequately and avoid this periodic occurrence of flooding.

M. Ribordy-W.F.Recksiedler: That By-Law No. 932 authorizing the sale of debentures to enable the Municipality to make a grant to the Boyne Valley Hostel Corporation at Carman, be given second reading.

W.F.Schellenberg-G.P.Goossen: That By-Law No. 933 being a by-law for the purpose of authorizing the submission of By-Law No. 932 to the ratepayers of Township Six and Range Two, W.P.M., having been read a first time, be now read a second and thrid time and passed.

C.J.Neufeld-M.Ribordy: That we appoint Geo. P. Goossen and Ed. Saurette as our representatives to attend meetings to study the possibility of constructing a nursing home or hostel in the Morris Hospital District.

C. J. Neufeld-W.F.Schellenberg: That we request the Dept. of Public Works to,place a bituminous mat on the flankage through the Village of Lowe Farm, at the time when P.T.H. #23 is being paved.




G. P. Goossen-W.F.Recksiedler: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$17,893.77 be passed for payment.
