

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

July 9, 1965

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of June 11, meeting were read and adopted by motion of G. P. Goossen and W.F.Recksiedler.

C.J.Neufeld-G.P.Goossen: That By-Law No. 930, being a by-law for the purpose of transferring certain lands from the Kronsweide S.D. #1030 to the Lowe Farm Consolidated S.D. #2377, having received the approval of the Minister, be now read a third time and passed. Carried

C.J.Neufeld-Ed. Saurette: That the increases in assessment as shown in "Exhibit A" of the Assessment Branch, dated June 14, 1965, be added to the current Tax Roll. Carried

W.F.Schellenberg-M.Ribordy: That we subscribe to a membership in the Hudson Bay Route Association, at \$25.00. Carried

G.P.Goossen-W.F.Recksiedler: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$14,688.75 be passed for payment. Carried


A letter was read from the Water Control & Conservation Branch, setting out the procedure for handling claims regarding 1965 Flood Damage, namely:


- (1) 50% compensation to municipalities re damage to MUNICIPAL ROADS, as approved by the Minister.
- (2) 50% compensation to municipalities re damage to MUNICIPAL DRAINS and pertinent structures, as approved by the Minister.
- (3) The Municipality will accept requests requests from owners of private buildings for assistance toward repairing damage to buildings and permanent fixtures, during 1965 ~~xxxx~~ spring break-up.

By-Law No. 932 authorising the Municipality to borrow \$4,248.00 for the purpose of making a grant to the Boyne Valley Hostel Corporation at Garman, will be submitted to a vote of the ratepayers of: TOWNSHIP 6, RANGE 2 WPM, on TUESDAY, JULY 27th between the hours of 9 o'clock in the forenoon to 6 o'clock in the afternoon, at the MASONIC HALL, SPERLING, Manitoba.

All municipal employees were requested to consider July 15th as a Stampede Holiday and if at all possible attend the stampede that Thursday. Pay for a 10 hour day will be allowed.
