Minutes The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris met on the above date at its regular monthly meeting, with all members present. The minutes of July 9th meeting were read and adopted by motion of C. J. Neufeld and Ed. Saurette.

Drainage Surveys E. Saurette-W.F.Recksiedler: That we request the Drainage Maintenance Boards to survey the following locations for improvements to our drainage system.  
1. South and East of Sec. 24-5-2 EPM ("X")  
2. Drain 111 in "V4".  
3. Portions of the "Moyer" and "Cobb" drains.  
4. Drain East of Sec's: 33-28-21 & 16, in 5-1 EPM.

Rent re E.Guenther C. J. Neufeld-M.Ribordy: That we pay C.P.Kroeker, Lowe Farm, \$12.00 a month rent for the house occupied by Ed. Guenther, commencing Aug. 1.

B/L 934\* Official Time C.J.Neufeld-W.F.Schellenberg: That By-Law No. 934, being a By-Law for the purpose of setting the "Official Time " for the municipality, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed.

Re-construct Kronsgard Drain W.F.Recksiedler-C.J.Neufeld: That the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris requests the Water Control & Conservation Branch to re-construct by deepening and widening the "Kronsgard Drain", as petitioned for by 16 ratepayers along said drain.

C. of R. Oct. 8. G. P. Goossen-W.F.Schellenberg: That the Court of Revision for the purpose of hearing complaints against property and business assessments, changes in ownership and acreage and deletions from the Assessment Roll for 1966, be set for Friday Oct. 8th at 2 p.m.

Street Light changes W.F.Recksiedler-Ed. Saurette: That the Council authorize Manitoba Hydro to make the following changes to the street lighting system in SEWELL: Delete two 300 Watt street lights and install two 175 watt M.V. Luminaire street lights.

Street Light changes G. P. Goossen-C.J.Neufeld: That the Council authorize the Manitoba Hydro to make the following changes to the street lighting system in:  
SILVERPLAINS: Delete four 100 watt street lights and Install three 175 watt M.V. Luminaire street lights.  
ROSENORT: Install two 175 M.V. Luminaire street lights.  
McTAVISH: Delete four 100 watt street lights and Install four 175 watt M.V. Luminaire street lights.

BOUNDARY  
DRAIN

W. F. Schellenberg-W.F.Recksiedler:

WHEREAS the drain known as the  $\phi$  BOUNDARY DRAIN, is now under the jurisdiction of the Municipalities of Rhineland and Montcalm; AND WHEREAS the R.M. of Morris also drains a certain amount of water into the said Boundary Drain, and has contributed in the past to the reconstruction of said drain; AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable that an agreement be made respecting the re-construction and maintenance of the said Boundary Drain, between the Municipalities of: Rhineland, Morris & Montcalm;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rural Municipality of Morris agrees to contribute one-third of the cost of all future re-construction and maintenance of the Boundary Drain, providing that the R.M. of Rhineland and the R.M. of Montcalm agree to pay 33 1/3% each as their share of the cost of future maintenance and re-construction.

Be it further resolved that three representatives be appointed, one by the R.M. of Rhineland, one by the R.M. of Morris and one by the R.M. of Montcalm to recommend to each respective council any maintenance or re-construction required, before any work is commenced or undertaken and that all three municipalities agree before any work is done.

Be it further resolved that the representative of the R.M. of Morris be Councillor C.J.Neufeld, Lowe Farm.


