The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The minutes of November 12th meeting were read and adopted by motion of W. F. Schellenberg and W.F.Recksiedler.

Minutes

Civil Defence member C.J.Neufeld-E.Saurette: That we appoint George P. Goossen of Rosenort to replace our previous member, Otto Bunkowsky, now deceased, on the Civil Defence Committee for this area. Carried

Fox Hunting by aircraft C.J.Neufeld - W.F.Recksiedler: That we approve of Fox Hunting by aeroplane, to aeroplane operators resident in our municipality, providing that owners of planes are government licensed and adhere to provincial regulations. The Secretary is authorized to issue permits for this purpose. Carried

Tax Cancellation B.L.935 G.P.Goossen-W.F.Schellenberg: That By-Law No. 935, being a by-law for the purpose of cancelling certain Taxes, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed. Carried

Valley Agr. Soc. Member G. P. Goossen-M.Ribordy: That we appoint C. J. Neufeld as our member to the Board of the Valley Agricultural Society for 1966. Carried

Holiday Pay Bonus C.J.Neufeld-W.F.Schellenberg: That we pay our employees a bonus of 3% on their 1965 earnings, in lieu of holiday pay. Carried

Aid Increase Ed. Saurette-W.F.Schellenberg: That we increase the aid to Bernice Peck and Constance Nicholson of Morris, by \$10.00 a month or a monthly aid of \$40.00 each, till April 1st, 1966. Carried

Accounts G.P.Goossen-W.F.Recksiedler: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$174,246.78 be passed for payment. Carried

Special Metting A Special Meeting to discuss our Bridge Timber requirements for 1966, as well as purchase of a tractor, will be held FRIDAY, DECEMBER 17th at 1 p.m.


