The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members, excepting Bruce MacKenzie, present. C. J. Neufeld, deputy reeve, chaired the meeting.

Minutes G. Goossen-W.F.Schellenberg: That the minutes of May 13th be adopted as read.

Staff W.Recksiedler-W.Schellenberg: That we pay D. J. Harder and Alice Loving, each bonus \$100.00 for extra work which was incurred due to the Flood.

Arbitrator M.Ribordy-E.Saurette: That we appoint Louis Duvenaud, Sperling, as arbitrator re the petition of Herman Rogalsky and others praying for the transfer of certain ST.Hyacinth lands from the Cons. S.D. of St. Hyacinthe #2373 to the Cons. S.D. of Domain #2342. -Domain SD

Arbitrator G. Goossen-W.F.Recksiedler: That we appoint John Martens, Morris as arbitrator replacing re the petitions of B.Bergmann et al requesting the transfer of certain lands R.Loving from Melba S.D. to the proposed Horndean Cons. S.D. a n d W.H.Thiessen et al requesting the transfer of certain lands from Steinfeld S.D. to the Rosenfeld Cons. S.D. - This appointment being to replace Ray Loving, who due to ill health will be unable to act as arbitrator, as set out in resolutions of May 13th.

Closing G.Goossen-M.Ribordy: That we authorize closing of the office from June 13th to office June 13-17 June 17th inclusive, while the office staff is attending a Course in Municipal Administration, and that the expenses connected therewith be paid by the municipality.

Sale of W.F.Schellenberg-M.Ribordy: That we approve of the sale of Hospital property presently used for water ponds by the Altona Hospital District #24.

Dyking for G.Goossen-W.F.Schellenberg: That we request the Province of Manitoba to take Rosenort the necessary action to construct permanent dykes around the Village of Rosenort.

Rebuild G.Goossen-W.Schellenberg: That we request the Water Control & Conservation Branch and the Dept. of Public Works to rebuild the bridges situate at: Bridges 1. NE 31-5-2 WPM and 2. East of Section 1-6-1 EPM We strongly recommend that the bridge at Section 1-6-1 EPM be built at grade level.

Culvert G. Goossen-W.Recksiedler: That we request the Highways Department of the Province PTH #23 of Manitoba to install a culvert through PTH #23, North of Section 36-4-2 WPM to alleviate drainage problems.

Culvert M. Ribordy-W.F.Recksiedler: That we request the Highways Department of the Province thru the possibility of alleviating the flooding problem caused at the Village of Sperling, due to insufficient culverts installed through P.T.H. #3.

Accounts G. P. Goossen-W.F.Schellenberg: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$115,558.63 be passed for payment.

Water Tank Council authorized the purchase of a 40 gallon Hot Water Tank for the municipal residence.

Trophy Council authorized the purchase of a trophy for the "Steer Wrestling Contest" in the forthcoming Big "M" Stampede. Price not to exceed \$15.00.

Ambulance A drive to provide ambulance service for the community being served by the local Service Hospital is being spearheaded by the Morris Lions Club. Council endorsed this undertaking and indicated that a grant towards this project would be made.
Breffogle and Ouimet attended, requesting that road between R.L. 499 and 501 be taken over by municipality. - Council will investigate.
Council was of the opinion that setting the deadline for payment of taxes to Dec. 31st of the year in which taxes are levied would create a hardship to our farmers, due to the quota system being applied to the sale of grains. Recommended July 31st following the year in which taxes are imposed. (Being end of crop year)
