The Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by Ben Klassen, seconded by Gib. Cretton that the Minutes of July 12th Council meeting be adopted as read.

Ed. Saurette-G.Goossen: That we request the Manitoba Hydro to install one additional street light, 175 Mercury Vapor, on the most westerly portion on P.R. 205 at the west end of Aubigny. Carried

Ben Klassen-Gib Cretton: That we protest the following conditions to the Highways Department:

1. Poor maintenance and lack of gravel on Provincial Roads in District Three in our Municipality. ~~Carried~~
2. Ford Crossings in dangerous condition on P.R. 336 north of P.T.H. #23. ~~Carried~~
3. Poor placement of Detour Signs on P.R. 332 at the Tobacco Creek crossing. Carried

H. D. Earl-G.Goossen: That By-Law No. 977 for the purpose of adopting the Morris Planning Scheme 198A having received due advertising as required and no objections to the amendment to said Plan having been received, be now read a second and third time and passed. Carried

Ben Klassen-W.Recksiedler: That we enter into an agreement with Jake and John Rempel, executor of Lowe Farm, to purchase the easterly 66 feet of Lot 12, Plan 431 at \$10.00 a foot, for road purposes, and that we engage the services of A.L.Hayward, Winnipeg to survey this area and continuing along proposed 6th street in the Village of Lowe Farm Carried

H.D.Earl-W.F.Recksiedler: That Alice Loving be declared Acting Secretary-Treasurer during the absence of the Clerk while on holidays from August 26th to September 14th, 1968, and shall while she fills this office, have all the powers and perform all the duties of the celrk. Sec. 346, Municipal Act. Carried

W. Recksiedler-Ben Klassen: That we approve of the shingling of the Municipal Shed, which is in bad state of repair, and employ some of our equipment operators during the time they are idle, due to inclement weather conditions. Carried

G.P.Goossen-Gib Cretton: That By-Law No. 979 being a by-law to provide for the transfer and sale of certain lands formerly owned by the School District of Boyne No. 21, having been read a first time, be now read a second and third time and passed. Carried


Ed. Saurette-H.Earl: That we request the Water Control Branch to take over the Drain between River Lots 512 and 514 from the Red River to the Angle Drain. Carried

G. Cretton-Ben Klassen: That we request the Water Control Branch, Dept. of Highways, to clean out the outside drain on the South side of the ~~AN~~ Channel. Carried


G. Goossen-G.Cretton: That the accounts as approved by the Finance Committee for \$18,285.74 be passed for payment. Carried

Members of the R.M. of Roland Council attended the meeting to discuss cost sharing relative to the reconstruction and maintenance of drainage channels which are of mutual benefit to both municipalities. A very amicable discussion was held and it was decided to draft an agreement setting out the responsibilities of each municipality as pertains to these drains.
