The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. Harvest season ~~and~~ prompted the early start of the meeting.

A.K.Fast-G.P.Goossen:- That the minutes of the August 10th Council meeting be adopted as read.

G.M.Cretton-M.A.Caron:

That the treasurer shall add to the Tax Roll those items listed by the Assessor in "Exhibit A" dated August 28, 1973.

Ben Klassen-G.P.Goossen:

That By-Law No. 1050, being a by-law for the purpose of authorizing the execution of a contract with Manitoba Hydro for the supply of electrical power for Street Lighting for a term of 5 years, be read a first, second and third time and passed. Sec. 183(2) of the Municipal Act be suspended.

W.F.Recksiedler-G.M.Cretton: That the Council and Staff be authorized to attend the annual Municipal Convention to be held November 20, 21 and 22 at the Fort Garry Hotel in Winnipeg and the expense allowance per representative be set at \$35.00 per day. *amended Oct 12/73*

A.K.Fast - M.A.Caron:

That we request a plan of survey be made covering the right-of-way purchases along the following drains: "Lewis" - "Brown" and "Burnett".

W.F.Recksiedler-G.M.Cretton:

That we grant the Hudson Bay Route Association the sum of \$50.00 for 1973.

Ben Klassen-G.P.Goossen: That we increase the wage schedule to our employees by 10 cents an hour, effective September 1st, 1973.


M.A.Caron - A.K.Fast:
