

The Rural Municipality of Morris
October 12, 1973

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. The newly elected council members, Benjamin A. Wiebe and Alvin Rempel attended, and were duly welcomed and introduced to members of council.

Ben Klassen-Geo. Goossen: That the minutes of Sept. 14th regular meeting and those of Sept. 25th Special meeting be adopted as read.

G.P.Goossen-M.A.Caron: That we request the Manitoba Water Services branch of the Provincial Government to make a study of the possibility of supplying water and sewage to the Village of Rosenort and surrounding area, as well as a cost estimate of such a project.

G.M.Cretton- G. Goossen: That we accept the recommendation of the Advisory Commission of the Morris Planning Scheme (Rural) and have the 1968 Scheme amended by establishing an "A1" Rural District as was originally incorporated in the scheme.

A.K .Fast-M.A.Caron: That we authorize two grader operators to attend a school for operators of "Champion" motor graders, to be held in Winnipeg on Nov..12th; expenses connected therewith to be paid by the municipality.

W.F.Recksiedler-G.M.Cretton: That the resolution of Sept. 14th setting out the rate of expense allowance for attending the Municipal Convention, be rescinded.

G.M. C retton-W.F.Recksiedler: That the Council, immediate past councillors and office staff be authorized to attend the Municipal Convention to be held Nov. 20, 21 and 22 at the Fort Garry Hotel in Winnipeg and the expense allowance per representative be set at \$20.00 per day, with the municipality paying the hotel accommodations.

W.Recksiedler-G.M.Cretton: That we request the Water Control Branch to give us a survey and design on the proposed construction of a bridge across the Morris River at NE 17-5-1 EPM; bridge to be about 200 feet in length.

G.P.Goossen-A.K.Fast: That we request authority from the Highways Department to construct a service road North of P.R. 205, West of the Dyke to Willow Street in the Village of Rosenort.

The Annual Court of Revision to hear appeals against the 1974 assessments was held at 2 p.m. with assessors Jack Fehr & Hugh Lungair of the assessment branch in attendance. Two written appeals were received and considered; one appeal granted the other not allowed.

Johnny Dueck attended the meeting, expressing thanks for the smooth way our 1973 gravel program was conducted; no complaints from truckers and very minor discrepancies in the gravel records. He presented Council with tickets, good for steak dinners at Burke's. Reeve Earl expressed council's thanks for this gesture of good will.


A.K.Fast-M.A .Caron: That the accounts as examined by Council and approved by the Finance Committee for \$19,712.80 be passed for payment.
