

The RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS  
December 14, 1973

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular monthly meeting on the above date with all members present. It was moved by Marcel Caron, seconded by Alvin Rempel that the minutes of November 9th council meeting be adopted as read.

A letter from the Manitoba Water Services Board informed that it will undertake engineering studies for the Villages of Aubigny, Rosenort, Lowe Farm and Sperling regarding water supply; however, these studies are not likely to be completed before the fall of 1974.

Plains Western Gas Ltd. has made an application to the Utility Board for a rate increase, effective in January 1974.

G.M.Cretton-B.A.Wiebe: That we pay an honorarium to Andre Marion of \$100. for services rendered in supervising the 1973 weed mowing program in the municipality.

W.F.Recksiedler-B.A.Wiebe: That we make the following grants for 1973:

A. K. Fast - M.A.Caron: That we appoint Benjamin A. Wiebe, Lowe Farm, as our member to the Morris-Montcalm Weed Control District for the years 1974 and 1975.

Alvin Rempel-G.M.Cretton: That we rebate \$365.72 to Peter D. Siemens, Rosenort, being two years business tax when Rosenort Feed Mill was not in operation.

W.F.Recksiedler-B.A.Wiebe: That we concur with the request of the Canadian National Railways to the Canadian Transport Commission for approval of removing the freight and passenger shelter at Kane, Man.

G.M.Cretton-B.A.Wiebe: That By-law No. 1053 being a by-law for the purpose of cancelling certain Tax es, be read a first, second and third time and passed, and Sec. 183(2) of the Mun. Act be suspended in this case.

Marcel Caron-W.Recksiedler: That we transfer to the Town of Morris the balance of our population of 1779 for use in its application for further funds from the Manitoba Emergency Loan Fund.

A.K.Fast-Alvin Rempel: Whereas the diaposal grounds on River Lot 432 are no longer being used for the purpose intended, and whereas "Yves Guillou" has offered to purchase said property, Now therefore be it resolved that we sell to Mr. Guillou these grounds consisting of about 2.33 acres at \$200.00, plus legal fees involved in transfer of said land.

W.Recksiedler-G.M.Cretton: That we tender for our Diesel Fuel requirements for 1974; tenders to be in hands of Secretary by Jan. 11, 1974.

A.K.Fast-M.A.Caron: That we order \$1,500 worth of culverts from Armco Drainage and a like amount from Westeel-Rosco for 1973 delivery.

Alvin Rempel-M.A.Caron: That the accounts as examined by council and approved by the Finance committee for \$255,671.01, be passed for pay't.

The meeting adjourned and council and wives motored to Sperling to enjoy a scrumptuous Christmas Dinner at the residence of Gib Crettons.
