

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, September 24th, 1981 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris with Reeve Alvin Rempel presiding. Present were Councillors: Dan Thiessen, W. F. Recksiedler, George St. Helaire, Roy Kornelsen, Glenn Curdt, Lenore Eidse.

The meeting was held to deal with rezoning by-law concerning our planning scheme and other items concerning Council which were unanimously agreed upon by Council to be dealt with.

Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen:
#291/81. Whereas Section 758 of the Municipal Act provides that a municipality may add certain assessments to the tax roll; And Whereas the Council of the R. M. of Morris has received a letter dated September 21st, 1981 from the Morden Municipal Assessment Branch indicating certain property assessments which may be added to the assessment roll of the R. M. of Morris; Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the R. M. of Morris does now authorize the property assessments listed on the above mentioned letter be now added to the assessment roll of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

Mr. A. Gagne of M.A.C. Hauling met with Council to discuss our 1982 gravel purchases and he proposed to Council that we should consider purchasing 1982 gravel in 1981 with payment being made in 1982. Due to possible increases in prices, it was felt that it may indeed be advantageous to obtain a price this fall for our 1982 gravel purchases.


