

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held a Special Meeting at 7:00 P.M. on Friday, December 18th, 1981 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Alvin Rempel presided.

Present were Councillors: Roy Kornelsen, Lenore Eidse, Dan Thiessen, Glenn Curdt, W. F. Recksiedler.

The meeting was held for the purpose of interviewing applicants for the position of Assistant Secretary-Treasurer and the possible hiring of same and also to consider employees salaries.

At the start of the meeting Council interviewed the candidates of Eileen Siegel, Roland Hamilton, Heather Peters and Irma Bjarnason, and Barry Hunter did not appear for an interview. The interview with each candidate lasted approximately 15 minutes and Council questioned each individual regarding their application and any questions by the candidates were also answered. Following the interviews, Council then deliberated on the question of who to hire for the position.

Hiring Ass't Sec.-Treas. Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Glenn Curdt: #444/81. Resolved that Mr. Roland G. Hamilton be hired as Assistant Secretary-Treasurer at a starting salary of \$16,000.00 per year with duties to commence February 1st, 1982.

Carried.

Salary Sec.-Treas. Moved by Dan Thiessen, Seconded by Lenore Eidse: #445/81. Resolved that we raise the Secretary-Treasurer, Grant Macaulay's wages to \$27,000.00 plus \$2,000.00 for expense account beginning January 1, 1982.

Carried.

Salary Caretaker Moved by Glenn Curdt, Seconded by Lenore Eidse: #446/81. Resolved that Mrs. Theresa Marion's salary for 1982 for the caretaking of the building be now set at \$520.00 per month.

Carried.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
