

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held its regular meeting at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, October 13th, 1983 in the Council Chambers of the R. M. of Morris.

Reeve Alvin Rempel presided.

Present were Councillors: Lenore Eidse, W. F. Recksiedler, George St. Hilaire, Roy Kornelsen, Glenn Curdt, Dan Thiessen.

- Minutes Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by George St. Hilaire: #416/83. Resolved that the minutes of the September 8th, 1983 regular meeting and the September 22, 1983 special meeting be now adopted as presented.
Carried.
- M.T.S. Moved by Roy Kornelsen, Seconded by George St. Hilaire; buried cable #417/83. Whereas the Manitoba Telephone System has written to Council requesting their approval for the installation of buried cable South of Section 3-6-1E and in Rosenort on Main Street into Riverbend Feedmill; Therefore Be It Resolved that Council has no objections to these installations and authorize the Secretary-Treasurer to sign the approval form.

- 1982 Moved by Lenore Eidse, Seconded by Glenn Curdt: Added Taxes #418/83. Resolved that the 1982 added building taxes on Roll No. 222800 being part of the SE¼ of 17-6-1E be now cancelled for the period from January, 1982 to June, 1982 inclusive.

- Good Roads Moved by George St. Hilaire, Seconded by Roy Kornelsen: Banquet #419/83. Resolved that Reeve Alvin Rempel or a council alternate and Henry Hildebrand be appointed to attend the Manitoba Good Roads Association Annual Banquet in Brandon on November 4, 1983 and that the municipality now authorize payment for the banquet tickets of the representatives and their wives if they are attending.

- Delegation Mr. Sam Hoffman presented a letter of Council indicating he was not pleased with the article in the local newspaper stating that contractors would have charged more to build the bridge south of Riverside than was stated as a cost estimate of actual municipal costs. The article stated that a contractor would charge up to \$250,000.00 to build the bridge and as a former bridge contractor Mr. Hoffman took offence to this and stated that he could build the bridge much cheaper than was stated. Council listened to his presentation and the matter was left at that point.

Council then recessed for lunch at 12:00 o'clock noon to reconvene at approximately 1:00 P.M.
- Delegation Mrs. Margje Mengerink appeared before Council on behalf of her subdivision application and her only comments to Council were to answer questions or concerns regarding her subdivision application. Council did ask a few minor questions regarding the matter and the delegation ended.
- Delegation Mr. Wendell Fewster, representing the Sperling Fire Department requested that Council consider their department for purchasing a fire truck in the near future. Council realized their concern and indicated that they should keep a lookout for a used vehicle that would fit into the existing fire hall. It was felt that a used vehicle would be more appropriate.
- Delegation Mr. Al Roney, Sargent of the Morris R.C.M.P. Detachment, met with Council to discuss any problems or councils concerns regarding policing. Following some discussion on the matter, the delegation ended.
- Delegation Mr. Art Dueck met with Council to discuss the proposed rerouting of the drain through Section 2-5-1W. They discussed matters of dilling in the existing drain, engineering drawings being required and also the matter of expenses for the project.


