PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to subsection 318(1) of *The Municipal Act* that the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris has scheduled a **public hearing at the Lowe Farm Community Centre located at 28 Main Street (PTH 23) in Lowe Farm, Manitoba on Tuesday, November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 10:00 A.M.** Council will hear any potential taxpayer who wishes to make representation, ask questions, or register an objection to Special Service Plan No. 2020-01.

### SUMMARY OF SPECIAL SERVICE PLAN:

The intent of the **Special Service Plan 2020-01** is to continue providing curbside collection of solid waste within the communities of Rosenort, Sperling and through a rural loop as listed on Schedule "B" of the Special Service Plan.

Previously properties in Sperling and the "Rural Loop" were based on a User Pay system, whereas properties in the Local Urban District of Rosenort had the service fees included within their taxes based on property assessments. Special Service Plan 2020-01 provides for all of these properties to be treated on a User Pay Principal. Proposed fees are shown on the opposite page.

Potential taxpayers wishing to object to the Special Service plan may file a notice of objection, by mail or in person, with the Chief Administrative Officer, at the Administration Office located at 207 Main Street North, Morris, Manitoba by November 10, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. All objections, written or verbal, must be filed prior to the adjournment of the hearing and must contain the name and address of the person filing the objection, identify the property in respect of which the objection is filed and state the grounds of the objection.
