



Various Public Works Positions

The Rural Municipality of Morris is located minutes south of Winnipeg and comprises approximately 400 square miles. With a growing population of 3,049 and a very active farming and manufacturing community we boast several urban centres such as Rosenort, Lowe Farm, Sperling, Aubigny and several smaller hamlets. The Town of Morris is also situated within our boundaries, however they have their own municipal government. Although sometimes prone to spring flooding, we also have some of the best farmland in Manitoba.

We are currently advertising to fill **three (3)** positions within the Public Works Department as follows:

Equipment Operator – The ideal candidate will have familiarity/experience with the operation of various municipal equipment such as excavators, graders, skids steers, tractors, etc. Class 1 Manitoba Drivers licence, with air brake endorsement, would be preferred, however Class 3 Manitoba Drivers Licence with air brake endorsement would be a minimum.

Utility Operator – The ideal candidate would already have completed the Manitoba Water & Wastewater Associations technical training as offered by Red River Polytechnic. This position is being added to our staff to provide additional support to our present Utility Operator. A Manitoba Class 3 Drivers Licence with air brake endorsement would be a great additional asset to possess.

CET/GIS Operator – We are seeking someone that would have training/familiarity working with Geographical Information Systems in a municipal environment. The ideal candidate would have formal training as a Civil Engineering Technologist and duties may vary, depending on the qualifications and aptitude to the individual hired for the position.

Salary Grids are in place for the Equipment Operator and Utility Operator, however the CET/GIS Operator would be considered a new position and salary will need to be determined depending on the qualifications of the person hired to fill the position. It should also be noted that the Equipment Operator and the Utility Operator positions are members of the Operating Engineers of Manitoba Local 987.
