



The Public Utilities Board has approved a water rate increase for the Pembina Valley Water Cooperative (PVWC) for water sales to its municipal members, effective January 1, 2023. Therefore, the Rural Municipality of Morris has approved By-Law 1773-23 to “pass through” the increase to consumers.
