
Helping Manitobans Make Ends Meet

School Tax Rebate

This year over 600,000 property owners will share \$453 million in school tax rebates. It's part of an ongoing commitment that has put over \$1 billion back into the pockets of Manitoba families by reducing the education portion of your property taxes.



Rebates Coming Soon

Your School Tax Rebate cheque from the Manitoba government will arrive **before** your municipal property taxes are due.

Note: You must pay the full balance owing on your property tax notice.

The Manitoba government is helping Manitobans ease the financial strain by reducing taxes while continuing to provide historic funding for schools. The average rebate for homeowners will be \$774.

Residential and Farm Properties

Property owners will see a net reduction of 50 per cent in education portion of property taxes for 2023.

- A rebate cheque will be issued for 50 per cent of the school division special levy, as reflected on your 2023 municipal property tax notice.
- Farm property owners must still apply for the Farmland School Tax Rebate.

Other Properties

Property owners will receive a rebate cheque for 10 per cent of the total school division special levy and education support levy for 2023.
