PUBLIC NOTICE
BOARD OF REVISION**

Public notice is hereby given that the **2025** preliminary assessment roll for the Rural Municipality of Morris is open for inspection at the Municipal office - 207 Main Street North in Morris, Manitoba during regular business hours. Applications for revision may be in accordance with section 42 and 43 of the Assessment Act:

42(1) A person in whose name property has been assessed, a mortgagee in possession of property under section 114(1) of the Real Property Act, an occupier of premises who is required under the terms of a lease to pay the taxes on the property, or the assessor may make application for the revision of an assessment roll with respect to:

- a) liability to taxation;
- b) amount of an assessed value;
- c) classification of property; or
- d) a refusal by an assessor to amend the assessment roll under subsection 13(2)

43(1) An application for revision must

- a) be made in writing;
- b) set out the roll number and legal description of the assessable property for which a revision is sought.
- c) state the grounds on which the application is based; and
- d) be filed by delivering it or causing it to be delivered to the municipal office on or before **Monday, September 23, 2024**.

The Board of Revision will sit on **Wednesday, October 9th, 2024 at 11:00 a.m.** at the Rural Municipality of Morris Administration Office located at 207 Main Street North in Morris, Manitoba, to hear applications for revisions to **2025** assessments and **2024** supplementary tax notices.
